Immersive Arts is a brand-new funding and support programme.

The funding programme aims to:

- support artists across the UK who are working with technology to make immersive art.
- encourage artists from all backgrounds to explore working with immersive technology.
- support artists with different levels
 of experience to explore,
 experiment and expand how they
 work.

What is Immersive Art?



Immersive art means making art using technology in a way that creates an engaging experience for an audience.



Immersive art can have different meanings and be made in different ways.











It can mean creating 'virtual realities' or changed reality experiences for an audience that can:

- be multi-sensory
- bridge the gap between physical and digital spaces
- connect people with each other and the environment
- change the way we think about and create art

Why apply to the fund?



To apply for funding you just need to be an artist or creative person who is curious about using technology.



You do not need experience of using technology to make art or be 'tech-savvy' (although you can be).





We will support you to figure out what you want to create.

We can help you to do this through a mixture of:

- Funding
- Training
- Research and events

About the funding



The **Immersive Arts fund** has £3.6 million available for artists.



This is available for artists from **2025 until 2027.**



We will fund over 200 artists based in the UK through **3 funding strands**:

- 1. Explore
- 2. Experiment
- 3. Expand









1. Explore

£5,000 grants for artists with little or no experience of immersive arts. This funding strand will help artists:

- Try out immersive arts
- Develop basic skills and knowledge of immersive arts
- Experience some immersive artworks
- Meet other people making immersive artworks and explore working together



2. Experiment

£20,000 grants are available for artists who are:

- ready to get their ideas off the ground
- want to test their work with an audience

3. Expand

£50,000 grants are available for artists and arts organisations who are:

 already developing an immersive art project

This funding will help artists to progress their project and take it to the next stage



Who can apply to the fund?



You can apply for an Immersive Arts grant if you are:

- An individual artists or creative practitioner
- An arts-based organisation, small group or collective (10 people or fewer if you are applying for Experiment. Up to 50 people for Expand)
- Based in the UK
- Aged over 18 years
- Have a UK bank account in your own name




To apply for a grant, you'll need to create an account on our website.

When to apply to the fund



The first round of funding for all three strands is open until midday, Monday2 December 2024.



Round 1 Funding Timetable

Funding Strand	Deadline	Applicant notified	Project time frame
Explore	2 December 2024	February 2025	March - August 2025
Experiment	2 December 2024	February 2025	March - November 2025
Expand	This strand has two-stages to the application process, to help protect artists' time and energy.		
Expand Stage 1 Expression of interest	2 December 2024	January 2025	March 2025 - February 2026
Expand Stage 2 Interview	February 2025	February 2025	March 2025 - February 2026

 English or Welsh or British sign language


Our application guidelines are available in different formats:
